# **Policy Purpose**

This policy aims to enhance student motivation, encourage active participation, and support academic success through structured initiatives.

#### **Policy Scope**

This policy applies to all students, faculty, and administrative staff involved in academic and extracurricular activities. It addresses lack of motivation at Wigwe University focuses on fostering student engagement, well-being, and academic success.

#### **Policy Guidelines**

# 1. Student Engagement and Support Framework

- 1.1 Support Systems: The university shall provide academic counseling, peer mentorship, and access to mental health resources to support students facing motivational challenges.
- 1.2 Engaging Learning Methods: Faculty members are encouraged to integrate interactive teaching approaches such as group discussions, hands-on projects, and real-world applications to boost engagement.
- 1.3 Excursions & Educational Trips: The university shall organize field trips, industry visits, and cultural excursions to provide students with practical exposure and a broader learning experience.
- 1.4 Extracurricular Development: Students shall have access to clubs, leadership programs, and internships designed to spark interest beyond academics.
- 1.5 Recognition & Incentives: Outstanding academic and extracurricular contributions shall be acknowledged through awards, scholarships, and commendations.
- 1.6 Personalized Academic Plans: Advisors shall work with students to create goal-oriented learning paths, ensuring clarity in academic and career objectives.



## 2. Implementation & Enforcement

- 2.1 Faculty and staff shall actively monitor student participation and offer guidance where needed.
- 2.2 Workshops on goalsetting, time management, and career planning shall be conducted regularly.
- 2.3 The university shall establish a feedback system where students can express concerns about their academic experience.

## 3. Review & Improvement

- 3.1 This policy shall be periodically assessed based on student feedback and academic performance trends to ensure effectiveness.
- 3.2 This approach balances institutional support with student responsibility, helping to create a more engaging university environment.
